The Langley School District is accepting applications for a Trades Certified Cabinet Maker in our Maintenance Department for a Continuing assignment. Individuals will perform a variety of tasks related to the installation and repair a variety of cabinets and millwork in School District buildings.

Individuals must have the following qualifications:

- Completion of Grade 12
- Apprenticeship and/or Trades Qualification Certificate (Cabinet Making)
- BC Driver's License
- Ability to perform a variety of skilled carpentry tasks in cabinetry and millwork and in the construction and maintenance of school district facilities.
- Thorough and current knowledge of the standards, practices, regulations, methods, tools and equipment of the trade.
- Ability to understand and effectively carry out general oral and written instructions with a minimum of supervision.
- Skill in the use of tools of the trade.
- Ability to read and interpret blueprints and work sketches.
- Ability to communicate effectively using courtesy and tact in the explanation and exchange of information.
- Ability to determine, judge and select appropriate course of action within limits of established methods and procedures.
- Physical ability to perform the required duties
