



# SEASONAL GROUNDSKEEPER – STUDENTS

## (TEMPORARY)

The Greater Victoria School District provides public educational services to over 20,000 students in the Greater Victoria Area, encompassing six municipalities. To provide this service, the District has a current operating budget of \$208 million and employs approximately 3,500 staff; which includes, teachers, administrators, support staff, psychologists, speech and language pathologists and exempt managerial staff.

The Seasonal Groundskeeper is described in Article 1.11 of the collective agreement and defines the role for those people who are enrolled full time in a post-secondary institution and working for the District between April 1<sup>st</sup> and September 30<sup>th</sup>.

The successful candidate must:

- Be enrolled in a full time post-secondary institution and provide supporting documentation
- Valid Class 5 British Columbia Driver's License
- Must be physically able to perform all duties as noted in the Position Description
- Have experience in the operation and maintenance of equipment related to grounds
- Have a certificate from a post-secondary institute showing successful completion of instruction in basic arc welding/cutting to a minimum of 36 hours or be able to demonstrate a basic skill level or ability to obtain within 1 year of hire date
- Registration as a Canadian Playground Inspector within the Canadian Playground Safety Institute or ability to obtain within 1 year of hire date
- Experience in the operation and maintenance of equipment related to grounds
- Knowledge in grounds and landscaping maintenance practices and procedures
- Demonstrates ability to read and interpret plans of playfield and perimeter drainage
- Job-related safety requirements and techniques as outlined in the WorkSafe BC regulations
- Maintains a cooperative working relationship with other workers, supervisory and teaching staff, students, and the public

Salary: \$24.36 per hour plus 11% in lieu of benefits. This position falls within the CUPE Local 382 bargaining unit. Position Start Date: **July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022.**
