

HVAC TECHNICIAN

The Burnaby School District is recruiting for a **FULL-TIME** HVAC Technician. This position installs, services, and repairs a variety of heating and ventilation systems to ensure a safe and healthy environment in District buildings and facilities.

The HVAC Technician installs services, repairs and inspects heating and ventilating equipment by calibrating and repairing pneumatic and electronic controls and thermostats, including DDC systems and works with computer software (programming and scheduling) for automated heating and ventilating systems as required. The position also liaises with district staff on a variety of issues related to indoor air quality, heating and cooling of district buildings and facilities.

Required Qualifications & Experience:

- Completion of Grade 12
- British Columbia Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning Certificate and Gasfitter's Certificate (Class B) (class A is preferred) Trades Qualification (TQ)
- Restricted electrical ticket is an asset
- Experience as a Journeyperson in HVAC (post TQ) service coupled with boiler maintenance and DDC/building automation experience is required
- Valid B.C. Driver's License (Class 5)
- Thorough knowledge of current techniques, methods, procedures and equipment applicable to HVAC trade, plus computerized control software applications and equipment is required
